

## Ordinance No. 58.

Entitled: An Ordinance for the purchase of a town lot and appropriating money out of the general fund, for the payment thereof.

Canby does Ordain as follows:

Sec. 1. That the City Council of Canby Oregon hereby proposes to purchase a town lot within the City limits for the purpose of erecting a City Hall upon the same, and suitable accommodations for the use of the Fire department and to keep Fire apparatus in store ready for immediate use at all times, also a room suitable for the keeping of all the necessary material and apparatus of the street lighting department.

Sec. 2. That there be, and is hereby appropriated out of the general fund of the City of Canby the sum of One Hundred and thirty dollars for the purchase and payment of lot number four (4) in block numbered three (3) of the town of Canby, County of Clackamas and state of Oregon, as designated, numbered and described on the plat and surveys of said town, on file in the Clerk's Office of said County of Clackamas.

This Ordinance to take effect from and after its final passage and approval by the Mayor.
