

Ordinance No. 59.

Entitled: An Ordinance for the building and erecting a Town Hall on lot No. 4. of block No. 3. of the town of Canby, and appropriating, and providing for the borrowing of money to pay for said building.

Canby does Ordain as follows:

Sec. 1. That the City Council of Canby proposes to build and erect a Town Hall for the use of said Town, and for such other purposes as said Council shall deem proper and best. Said Hall to be 24 feet in height, 35 feet in width, and 70 feet in length, built of lumber and to be finished and fitted up in rooms below, and into a room suitable for a Public Hall above, together with the proper and necessary Ante rooms suitable for Town and Lodge purposes. Said Hall to be erected on lot No. 4. in block No. 3. in Canby. Said lot being the same lot purchased by the Town for Town purposes and use, and said Hall to be built by the lowest responsible bidder according to the exact plans and specifications hereafter to be adopted by the Council of Canby. Said Hall not to cost more than (\$1600.⁰⁰) sixteen hundred dollars.

Sec. 2. That said Council be hereby authorized and empowered to use out of the General fund of said Town such money as there may be therein for the building of said Hall, and be empowered to borrow the balance of amount of money to build said Hall, provided that the said amount borrowed do not exceed the sum of \$1000.⁰⁰ and to pledge the credit of the town of Canby for the amount so borrowed for said purpose.

This Ordinance to take effect from and after its fiscal passage and approval by the Mayor,
