

Ordinance No. 60

Entitled: An Ordinance to prevent the leading or driving or riding of animals on the sidewalks of Canby Oregon.

Canby does Ordain as follows:

Sec. 1. That any person or persons who shall lead, drive or ride, or cause to be lead or drove upon any of the sidewalks in said City, any horse or mule or other animal, or shall hitch, or cause to be hitched any animal to any post or fence so that said animal shall be upon or obstruct the sidewalk, he or they shall be deemed guilty of a violation of said Ordinance, and upon conviction thereof before the Mayor or Recorder of said City, shall pay a fine of not less than (\$2.⁰⁰) two dollars, nor more than (\$20.⁰⁰) twenty dollars for each and every offence and costs of suit.

This Ordinance to take effect, on and after the approval by the Mayor.

Passed the City Council on June 3rd 1901.
Approved by the Mayor June 11th 1901.
