

Ordinance No. 62.

Entitled: An Ordinance providing for the removal of moss from the roofs of buildings in Canby.

Canby does Ordain as follows:

Sec. 1. That written notices shall be given by the City Chief of Police to the Owners or occupants of all buildings within the limits from First to Third Streets, from "A" to "G" Streets of Canby to remove from the roofs of said buildings, all moss, dirt or combustible matter of whatever description that would likely endanger the property and buildings by fire, and such owners or occupants who shall fail or refuse to remove said moss or other inflammable matter within three days after the service of such notice, the same shall be removed, or caused to be removed by said City Chief of Police, at the expense of the owners of said buildings together with costs of suit.
