

## Ordinance No. 64.

Entitled: An Ordinance for the building and erecting a suitable building for the purpose of storing the City fire Truck and other fixtures belonging to the fire department, also, room in said building to store wood for the use of the City Hall, also for the use of the stone room.

Canby does Ordain as follows:

Sec. 1. That the City Council of Canby Oregon, proposes to build and erect a building for the purpose of storing the fire departments Truck and fixtures belonging to the City, for the use of said town, and for such other purposes as said Council shall deem proper and best, said building to be twenty four feet in length and sixteen feet in width, built of lumber, and to be finished and fitted up for such purposes, as above stated, said building to be erected on lot No. 4, block No. 3, in the rear of City Hall, and said building to be built by the lowest responsible bidder, according to the exact plans and specifications hereafter to be adopted by the City Council of Canby.

Sec. 2, That said City Council be hereby authorized and empowered to use out of the general fund of said town, such money as there may be, not otherwise appropriated, for the building of said structure.
