

Ordinance No. 70.

An Ordinance granting unto the Portland General Electric Company the right to erect poles and string wires thereon for the purpose of transmitting electric current upon the streets and alleys of the City of Canby.

Canby does Ordain as follows:

Sec. 1. It is hereby granted to the Portland General Electric Company, its Successors and Assigns, the right to erect and maintain poles and wires for Electric light and power purposes upon the streets and alleys of the City of Canby.

Sec. 2. Said Portland General Electric Company, its Successors or Assigns, shall erect such poles, and string such wires thereon, so as not to interfere with the free and unobstructed use of the streets for travel, and shall place its poles at such points on the said streets as may be designated by the City Council,

Sec. 3. Whenever it shall be necessary in erection of such poles, to dig, or in any manner interfere with any public street or alley, said Portland General Electric Company its Successors or Assigns, shall without delay, put such street or alley in as good condition, as it was before broken, dug up, or disturbed, and shall remove all surplus sand, earth, rubbish or other material from such street or alley.

Sec. 4. The said Portland General Electric Company, shall within ten days from the approval of this Ordinance file with the Recorder its written acceptance thereof, and thereafter shall be entitled to the rights hereby conferred, so long as it shall comply with the terms and conditions of this Ordinance.
