

Ordinance No. 75.

Entitled an Ordinance granting to the Macksburg Mutual Telephone Co. the right and privilege of Erecting, building and Erecting poles and wires, and maintaining in and over the streets and roads, alleys and public property of the Town of Canby, Poles and wires and other necessary materials for the transaction of the electric current or currents, sufficient and proper, and necessary for the maintenance and carrying on of the proper and necessary work and business of Said Telephone System.

Canby does Ordain as follows:

Sec. 1. The Macksburg Mutual Telephone Co., its successors and assigns are hereby granted the right of and privilege, and are hereby authorized and allowed to erect and put up, and in, upon and over the streets, alleys, roads and property of Canby Oregon, the proper and necessary poles and wires for the use and transmission of Telephone or other messages or use between any point or points on its lines or line.

Sec. 2. Said Macksburg Mutual Telephone Co., its successors, and assigns in the exercise of its rights hereby granted, Shall so erect its poles and string its wires, so as to not interfere with travel or traffic on the streets in Canby, and to so place its poles and wires as may be designated and required by the Town of Canby, and subject to the instruction and supervision of the Street Commissioner thereof, and the location thereof, and the removal thereof if proper and necessary, Shall be subject to any action at any time, of the city council of Canby Oregon.

Sec. 3. That before any poles are hereafter placed, or any work that will interfere

with any street or alley, the person performing said work, or digging holes for same, shall get a permit from the Street Commissioner for the same.

Sec. 4. The rights and privileges hereby conferred and granted shall expire, and become null and void at the end of (20) Twenty years from the date of this Ordinance, and the approval thereof by the Mayor.

Sec. 5. This Ordinance to go into effect and be in force, from and after its final passage, and approval by the Mayor.
