

## Ordinance No. 77.

An Ordinance granting to the Long Distance Telephone Company, its successors and assigns, the right to construct and operate in Canby Oregon, over and above the streets and alleys thereof, wires and other conductors for Telephone and Telegraph purposes,

Canby does Ordain as follows:

Sec. 1. The City of Canby hereby grants to the Northwestern Telephone Company its successors and assigns, for a period of Twentyfive years, from and after the passage of this Ordinance, the right to construct, maintain and operate in the streets of Canby, and alleys within said City, poles, wires and other appliances for the purpose of conducting Telephone and Telegraph business, work shall be done in compliance with the present, or any future Ordinance of said City of Canby, and under the supervision of the Committee on Streets, and the Street Commissioner,

Sec. 2. This Ordinance shall take effect, from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor,
