

Ordinance No. 81.

Entitled; An Ordinance defining the base of Elevation and Establishing the grade of first and "C." Streets;

Canby does Ordain as follows:

Sec. 1. The base for the determination of Elevation in establishing grades in Canby is hereby established as the top of the Stone monument at the intersection of first and "A." Streets, said base line having an assumed elevation of 100. feet.

Sec. 2. The grade of first Street in Canby, Oregon, is hereby established as follows: Beginning at the Easterly line of "A." Street at an Elevation of 100.10 feet; thence level across "A." Street; thence to the easterly line of "B." Street at an Elevation of 100.16 feet; thence level across "B." Street; thence to the Easterly line of "C." Street at an Elevation of 100.76 feet; thence to the westerly line of "C." Street at an Elevation of 101.34 feet; thence to the Easterly line of "D." Street at an Elevation of 102.55 feet; thence to the westerly line of "D." Street at an Elevation of 103.62 feet; thence to the Easterly line of "E." Street at an Elevation of 103.38 feet.

Sec. 3. "C." Street, The grade of "C." Street in Canby is hereby established as follows: Beginning at the North line of first Street at an Elevation of 100.76 feet on the East line of "C." Street, and at an Elevation of 101.34 feet on the West line of "C." Street; thence level to the South line of fourth Street; thence to the North line of fourth Street at an Elevation of 101.50 feet; thence to the South line of fifth Street at an Elevation of 105. feet.

Sec. 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect from and after its final passage and approval by the Mayor,
