

Ordinance No. 83.

Entitled: An Ordinance providing for the width, and Manner of Constructing Sidewalks in Canby Oregon.

Canby does Ordain as follows:

Sec. 1. All sidewalks hereafter constructed in Canby Oregon, shall be of asphalt, Stone, Cement, Artificial Stone or Wood.

Sec. 2. All sidewalks on first, second, third, fourth, fifth, "A", "B", "C", "D", "E", "F", and "G" Streets, shall be of an even width of Eight feet.

Sec. 3. all sidewalks hereafter constructed in Canby shall have a grade or fall towards the center of the street of one-fourth inch to each foot in width of walk.

Sec. 4. That all sidewalks hereafter constructed in Canby, shall have a curb, of not less than twelve inches deep, and three inches in thickness.

Sec. 5. That this Ordinance shall take effect, and be in force from and after its final passage and approval by the Mayor.
