

An Ordinance granting to M. J. Lee, his heirs and assigns, the right and privilege to construct, maintain and operate an electric light and power plant system, to erect poles and to string wires and appliances thereon, in, over, upon, across and through all the public streets, alleys, highways, parks and other public places in the town of Canby Oregon, for the purpose of generating, transmitting and furnishing light and power, or light or power to the town of Canby, and the Public for hire.

Canby does Ordain as follows:

Sec. 1. That M. J. Lee, his heirs and assigns be and are hereby granted the right and privilege of Erecting, Constructing, Maintaining, Operating and using in, over, upon, across, and through the public streets, alleys, highways, parks and places of the town of Canby State of Oregon, poles, and appliances and of stringing wires, fixtures and appliances thereon for the purpose of generating, conveying and furnishing Electric lights and Power to the said town of Canby, and the Public for hire.

Sec. 2. That all poles Erected, and wires strung shall be Erected and strung, as to height, and location of poles and stringing of wires, subject to the approval of the City Council of Canby,

Sec. 3. That the said M. J. Lee, his heirs or assigns shall within One year from the passage and approval of this Ordinance, begin the erection of said light and power plant, and to have a Power plant constructed of sufficient Capacity to furnish lights for the City of Canby within three years from the passage of this Ordinance and shall on or before beginning the same file acceptance hereof with the Recorder of said town of Canby, otherwise, this Ordinance shall be null and void.

Sec. 4. That said M. J. Lee, his heirs and Assigns agree to furnish free of charge to the City of Canby, the same number and size of lights that the Aurora Electric Company now furnishes free in the City Hall. Said lights so furnished to be placed at the place or places designated by the City Council.

Sec. 5. That the duration of this Franchise be Twenty five (25) years, but not Exclusive,

Sec. 6. That this Ordinance take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval, publication and acceptance.
