

Ordinance No. 87.

An Ordinance Entitled: an Ordinance to Assess, and make a Five (5) Mill Tax Levy on all property, real and personal, within the Corporate limits of Canby for general Municipal purposes:

Canby does Ordain as follows:

Sec. 1. That whereas, In accordance with Sec. 33. of the ^{City} Charter of Canby, the Council has power and authority within Canby, To Assess, levy, and collect taxes for general Municipal purposes, and whereas, such power and authority can only be enforced, or executed by Ordinance; and whereas, it being deemed necessary to provide funds for municipal purposes, be it resolved as follows:

Sec. 2. That there be and hereby is Levied a five mill tax upon all property, real and personal within the Corporate limits of Canby for general Municipal purposes, and that the same be placed on the Clackamas County taxroll for Collection as by Law required.

Sec. 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its final passage and approval by the Mayor.
