ORDINANCE NO. 128.

An Ordinance directing the treasurer of Canby to keep in a separate fund all moneys received from the use and consumption of water by the sale of bonds or otherwise from the waterworks of Canby.

CANBY DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the treasurer of Canby shall keep all moneys collected or received from the use and consumption of water or by the sale of bonds for the waterworks or otherwise, derived from or for the Canby waterworks' system, which said fund shall be separate and apart from the other funds of the city. That said money shall be paid out only on warrants drawn on the water fund of Canby and not otherwise.

Section 2. That the interest coupons of the \$18,000.00 issue of bonds dated August 1st, 1916, and the principal thereof shall be paid from said fund; provided, however, that if there is not sufficient money therein to pay the same, the treasurer of Canby is hereby directed to transfer from the general fund to the water fund of Canby such sums as may be necessary from time to time to pay the interest on said bonds.

Read for the first time August 7, 1916, and ordered posted for the reason that the charges of publication thereof were in the judgment of the Council excessive, and therefore said publication was dispensed with and the Recorder was instructed to post said Ordinance in three public and conspicuous places for a period of two full calendar weeks, to come up for final passage at a special meeting of the Council to be held on the 23rd day of August, at 8 o'clock P. M.
