

ORDINANCE NO. 139.

An Ordinance providing for the compensation of the Chief of Police of the City of Canby.

Canby does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. That the salary of the Chief of Police of the City of Canby, shall be Twenty five and 00/100 (\$25.00) Dollars per month.

SECTION 2. That all parts of ordinances in conflict herewith be, and the same are, hereby repealed.

Motion made and seconded that said ordinance be placed on its first reading, and that it be published. Motion carried.
