## ORDINANCE NO. 304

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE COMPENSATION AND BONDS OF THE RECORDER AND TREASURER.

Canby does ordain as follows:

Section 1. The salary of the recorder shall be fixed by the council.

Section 2. The treasurer shall receive as compensation a sum equal to .05 per cent of all tax funds handled by him and 1 percent of all collections on water and light bills.

Section 3. The recorder shall file with the mayor a good and sufficient surety bond payable to the city of Canby in the penal sum of \$1,000, payable in lawful money of the United States, with sureties approved by the mayor. Said bond shall be conditioned that said officer will faithfully discharge his respective duties, will account for and pay over all money that may come into the hands of said officer by virtue of his office, and will turn over to his successor in office all books, papers, and property belonging to the city that may come into the hands of said office.

Section 4. The treasurer shall file with the recorder a good and sufficient surety bond payable to the city of Canby in the penal sum of \$1,000, payable in lawful money of the United States, with sureties approved by the mayor. Said bond shall be conditioned that said officer will faithfully discharge his respective duties, will account for and pay over all money that may come into the hands of said officer by virtue of his office, and will turn over to his successor in office all books, papers, and property belonging to the city that may come into the hands of said officer by virtue of his office.
