

## ORDINANCE NO. 311

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE EXTINGUISHMENT OF FIRES AND FOR THE ORGANIZATION AND GOVERNMENT OF THE CANBY VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT.

Canby does ordain as follows:

Section 1. The power to do all that is necessary or convenient for the purpose of extinguishing fires in the city of Canby shall be vested in the Canby Volunteer fire department.

Section 2. The said Canby Volunteer fire department shall be organized, governed, and regulated in the manner prescribed by its constitution and by such bylaws as it may from time to time see fit to adopt.

Section 3. The fire chief shall be selected in the manner prescribed by the constitution and bylaws of the Canby Volunteer fire department, but subject to approval by the council.
