

ORDINANCE NO. 342.

And for the purpose of levying a tax on all taxable property, including both real and personal, within the corporate limits of the City of Canby, Oregon.

CANBY DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS, TO-WIT:

SECTION 1.—The Council of the City of Canby does hereby levy a tax of \$4667.80 on all of the taxable property, including both real and personal which is taxable for County and State purposes situated within the corporate limits of Canby; and which is to be collected as other taxes are collected within the State of Oregon by the Sheriff and Tax Collector of Clackamas County, for the fiscal year, July 1, 1946 to June 30, 1947.

SECTION 2.—Said Levy shall consist of a sum of \$4667.80, known as the reg-

ular city tax for the fiscal period of from July 1, 1946 to June 30, 1947.

SECTION 3.—WHEREAS, it is deemed best for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of Canby, an emergency is hereby declared and this Ordinance shall become immediately in full force and effect and operation upon its passage by the City Council of Canby, Oregon, and its approval by the Mayor.

Read for the first time at a special meeting of the City Council of Canby, Oregon, June 17, 1946. Passed and ordered published and to come up for final action at the regular meeting of the said Council to be held on July 1, 1946.
