ORDINANCE NO.

In pursuance of a certain Notice of Street Vacation, for the vacation of FIFTH Street between Grant and Fir Streets, and the ALIEY running between Fourth and Fifth Streets. from Grant to Fir Streets, within the corporate limits of the City of Canby, Clackamas County, Oregon, for the purpose of enlarging the Canby Grade School Buildings, which said notice was published in the Canby Herald of Canby, Clackamas County, Oregon, for four consecutive weeks, and the first publication thereof was as of January 8, 1948, and the last publication thereof was as of February 5, 1948, and no objections to such street and alley vacation having been fi with the Recorder of the City of Canby, Oregon, and no persons appearing before the City Council of the City of Canby, Oregon, to voice any objections or remonstrances thereto, CANBY DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That FIFTH STREET between Grant and Fir Streets, of the official plat and survey of the City of Canby, Clackamas County, Oregon, be and the same is hereby closed and dec red to be vacated to the public use of pedestrians, motor, and/or vehicular travel and rightof-way to the general public, except for public school purposes and matters pertaining thereto

SECTION 2. That the Alley running between Fourth and Fifth Streets, from Grant to Fir Streets, of the official plat and survey of the City of Canby, Clackamas County, Oregon, be and the same is hereby closed and declared to be vacated to the public use of pedestrians, motor. and/or vehicular travel and right-of-way to the general public, except for public school purposes and matters pertaining thereto.

SECTION 3. It is hereby adjudged and declared that existing conditions are such that thi act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety; and owi to the urgent necessity of enlarging and maintaining the public grade school of Canby, Oregon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this act shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after, its passage.
