

AN ACT AMENDING ORDINANCE No. 313,
ADDING A NEW RULE THERETO DEFINING
RESIDENTIAL USE OF WATER and
COMMERCIAL USE OF WATER.

To amend Ordinance No.313, governing and regulating the use of City
water in residential homes and commercial purposes.

THE CITY OF CANBY DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Applicable to domestic use of all residential customers, service under
the residential rate shall apply only to the use of water in a single private
dwelling and its appurtenances.

Private dwellings in which space is occasionally used for the conduct
of business by a person residing therein will be served under the residential
rate. Where a portion of the dwelling is used regularly for the conduct of
business, the water consumed in that portion so used will be separately metered
and billed under the Commercial Water Rate. If separate meters are not provided
by the customer, the entire premises shall be classified as non-residential and
billed accordingly. The Residential Rate shall not apply to service institutions
such as Clubs, Fraternities, Orphanages or Homes, recognized Rooming or Boarding
houses; the space in an apartment or other residential building occupied by more
than one family.

An emergency is hereby declared to exist by which this amendment shall
become immediately operative upon the passage of said amendment.

Read for the first time at the regular meeting of the City Council
held on Monday, April 4, 1949, ordered posted and to come up for
final action at the next regular meeting of the Council to be held
on Monday, May 2, 1949.
