

ORDINANCE No. 360

An Ordinance regulating the erection, or construction, or maintenance of an outside toilet or privy within the corporate limits of the City of Canby, Oregon.

THE CITY OF CANBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: It shall be unlawful for any person to erect, construct, or maintain an outside toilet or privy on any premises within the corporate limits of the City of Canby, Oregon.

SECTION 2: Any such outside toilets or privies already heretofore erected, constructed, or maintained, whether by the owner, lessor or lessee shall be removed from such premises within the City limits of the City of Canby, wheresoever located, within 120 days from the time this ordinance goes into effect.

SECTION 3: If any person having such outside toilet or privy upon such premises heretofore referred to, whether owner, lessor or lessee, shall fail, neglect or refuse to remove same from such premises within the time provided in Section 2 hereof as above, the owner, lessor or lessee of such premises, shall be subject, upon conviction thereof, to punishment by imprisonment in the city jail not less than one month, or more than four months, or by fine not less than \$50.00 nor more than \$200.00.

SECTION 4: It is hereby adjudged and declared that existing conditions are such that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation and protection of the public peace, health and safety and an emergency hereby is declared to exist, and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
