

An Ordinance for the purpose of levying a tax on all taxable property, including both real and personal, within the corporate limits of the City of Canby, Oregon.

CANBY DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS, TO-WIT:

SECTION 1. The Council of the City of Canby does hereby levy a tax of \$ 5775.00 on all of the taxable property, including both real and personal, which is taxable for County and State purposes, situated within the corporate limits of Canby and which is to be collected as other taxes are collected within the State of Oregon, by the Sheriff and Tax Collector of Clackamas County, for the fiscal year, July 1-1950 to June 30-1951.

SECTION 2. Said levy shall consist of the sum of \$ 5775.00, known as the regular city tax for the fiscal year or period from July 1-1950 to June 30, 1951.

SECTION 3. WHEREAS, It is deemed best for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of Canby, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall become immediately in full force and effect and operation upon it's passage by the City Council of Canby, Oregon and it's approval by the Mayor.

Read for the first time at a special meeting of the City Council of Canby, Oregon, June 15, 1950, passed and ordered published in the manner prescribed and to come up for final action at the next regular July meeting of said Council, as of July 3-1950.
