

An Ordinance establishing a local organization for Civil Defense in accordance with the State Civil Defense Plan and Program for the City of Canby; authorizing the Mayor to appoint a director of Civil Defense for the City of Canby and giving such Director all the powers and duties provided for in Chapter 434, Oregon Laws of 1949 ; and declaring an emergency.

CANBY DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1- That the Mayor shall have the power to appoint a Director of Civil Defense for the City of Canby, who shall have all the duties and powers as described in Chapter 434, Oregon Laws of 1949; and who shall have the power and duties of co-operating and co-ordinating his organization with the State of Oregon Civil Defense organization and with the similar Civil Defense organizations of the other political sub-divisions of the State of Oregon; and with all agencies of the Federal Government having comparable functions.

SECTION 2- The Director of Civil Defense for the City of Canby, when appointed shall have all the powers and duties prescribed in Chapter 434, Oregon Laws of 1949.

SECTION 3- It is hereby adjudged and declared that existing conditions are such that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace , health and safety and an emergency is hereby declared to exist; and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after it's passage by the City Council of Canby and approval by the Mayor.

Read for the first time at a regular meeting of the City Council of Canby held on Monday, August 7, 1950, ordered posted in the manner prescribed and to come up for final action at the next regular meeting of the Council to be held on Tuesday, September 5, 1950.
