WHEREAS, Third Avenue, in the City of Canby, Oregon, es-pecially between Ivy street and Locust street, is an unpaved gravelled street, and as a result hereof a great deal of dust and lirt is caused and created from the traffic on said Third Aveiue, to the annoyance and in-convenience of the citizens of Canby, residing along said Third Avenue, and that it is necessary hat said Third Avenue be oiled between said Ivy Street and Loust Street to alleviate such dirt and dust created by the traffic

f said street. THE CITY OF CANBY OR-DAINS AS FOLLOWS: SECTION 1. That the Super-ntendent of Public Works be, ord he hereby is authorized or. nd he hereby is authorized, orlered and directed to arrange for he oiling of said Third Avenue, etween Ivy Street and Locust treet, in the City of Canby, Oreon, as soon as circumstances nd conditions permit. SECTION 2. That the cost for

That the cost for he said oiling of Third Avenue, etween Ivy Street and Locust treet, shall be paid by the prop-rty owners along said Third venue and intersecting streets, enefitted thereby, and an as-essment shall be made against aid properties, cost to be pro-ated on front footage basis and ated on front footage basis, and lien is hereby declared to exist gainst said properties until uch assessment shall be paid.

SECTION 3. It hereby is ad-adged and declared that existing conditions are such that this rdinance is necessary for the nmediate preservation of the ublic health, peace and safety, and that an omergency bareby is nd that an emergency hereby is eclared to exist and that this rdinance take effect and be in ill force and effect immediately pon its passage and approval y the Mayor.
