

ORDINANCE NO. 487

AN ORDINANCE WITHDRAWING FROM THE CANBY RURAL FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT THAT PART THEREOF WHICH WAS ANNEXED TO THE CITY OF CANBY BY CITY ORDINANCE NO. 485.

WHEREAS, the Common Council for the City of Canby has elected to cause the withdrawal from the CANBY RURAL FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT of that part of said District heretofore annexed to the City of Canby by Ordinance No. 485 adopted July 19, 1965; and such election was made and declared by Resolution No. LVII adopted by the Canby City Council on the 19th day of July, 1965; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing on the question of such withdrawal was called to be held at the Canby City Hall at Canby, Clackamas County, State of Oregon, at 8:00 o'clock p.m., Oregon Daylight Savings Time, on Monday, August 16, 1965, and Notice of the date, time, place and purpose of such hearing was duly and regularly posted and published in the manner and for the time required by Oregon Revised Statutes 222.524; and Affidavits of the posting and publications of such Notice have been duly made and filed in the office of the Canby City Recorder; and

WHEREAS, the public hearing on the question of such withdrawal was duly and regularly held at the time and place as scheduled, but no person or persons appeared at such hearing either in person or otherwise to oppose or object to the proposed withdrawal, and at the conclusion of such hearing, the Canby City Council as the governing body of said City unanimously determined as shown by the records of such Council meeting that such withdrawal is for the best interests of said City, now therefore

THE CITY OF CANBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the following described part of the CANBY RURAL FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT which was annexed to the City of Canby by Ordinance No. 485 adopted July 19, 1965, shall be and the same is hereby withdrawn from said Fire Protection District:

A tract of land lying and being in Section 28, T. 3 S., R. 1 E., of the W.M., in the County of Clackamas and State of Oregon, described as follows:


Beginning at the southwest corner of Lot 56, Pruneland; running thence South along the southerly extension of the west line of said Lot 56 to a point in the south line of the Territorial Road; thence Northeasterly along the southerly line of said road and the northerly line of Lot 46 Canby Gardens to the northerly terminus of the west line of Amrine Road; thence North to the center line of the Territorial Road; thence North 78° 24' East along said centerline 20 feet, more or less, to an iron pipe set at the southwest corner of that tract conveyed to Mary L. Collins, et al, by deed recorded September 26, 1946, in Deed Book 377, page 429, Records of Clackamas County, Oregon; thence North along the west line of said Collins tract 945 feet, more or less, to the intersection of said west line with the easterly extension of the north line of Lot 54 Pruneland; thence West along said easterly extension and said north line of said Lot 54 Pruneland 660 feet to the northwest corner of said Lot 54; thence South along the west line of Lots 54, 55 and 56 Pruneland to the southwest corner of said Lot 56 and point of beginning.

Section 2: It being deemed by the Canby City Council that an emergency exists, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its final passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.

Passed on first reading at a regular meeting of the Canby City Council held on the 16th day of August, 1965; ordered posted in three public and conspicuous places in the City of Canby for a period of two (2) full calendar weeks as provided by the Canby City Charter; and to come up for final reading and action of the Canby City Council at a regular meeting thereof to be held on Tuesday, September 7, 1965, at the hour of 8:00 o'clock p.m., Oregon Daylight Savings Time, at the Canby City Hall.
