

ORDINANCE NO. 407

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE USE OF PUBLIC SEWERS; AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 394; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF CANBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Section 2-4 of Canby City Ordinance No. 394 is amended to read as follows:

The owner of all houses, buildings or properties used for human occupancy, employment, recreation or other purposes situated within the City of Canby within one hundred (100) feet of and abutting on any street, alley or right of way in which there is constructed a public, sanitary sewer is hereby required at his own expense to install suitable toilet facilities in said premises and then connect such facilities directly with the public sewer as soon as the same is available for use. Connection with the public sewer shall be made in accordance with the provisions of this ordinance, within ninety (90) days after date of official notice to do so. The availability of the public sewer for use in any particular case shall be determined by the City Engineer subject to the right of any person aggrieved thereby to appeal without formal notice directly to the City Council and the decision of the City Council as to whether or not a public sewer is available to any particular property shall be conclusive.

Section 2: Whereas an emergency exists and it is deemed necessary by the City Council of the City of Canby for the preservation of the peace, health and safety and general welfare of the citizens of said city, that this ordinance take effect immediately it shall take effect immediately upon its final passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.

Passed on its first reading at a regular meeting of the Canby City Council held on the 3rd day of February, 1958, ordered posted as provided by City Charter and to come up for final action at the regular meeting of the City Council to be held on the 3rd
