

ORDINANCE No. 414

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CONSTRUCTION OF AN EQUIPMENT STORAGE BUILDING AND PROVIDING FOR THE PAYMENT OF THE COST:

THE CITY OF CANBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the City Council for the City of Canby, Oregon, shall cause to be constructed on city property in the vicinity of N. E. Second and Juniper Streets, between N. E. Second Street and the Southern Pacific Company's tracks, a combination repair shop, storage building and warehouse for repairing and storing city equipment, tools and supplies.

Section 2: That such building shall be constructed according to plans and specifications to be prepared by the City Superintendent and approved by the City Council.

Section 3: That the total costs for the construction of said building shall be limited to a sum not exceeding \$8,500.00 and such costs shall be paid from either funds of the city now on hand and previously appropriated for such purpose or from funds to be budgeted for such purpose or a combination of both. If it is necessary for the city to budget over a period of more than one (1) year for the costs of constructing said building, the city may make such arrangements as it deems advisable for the interim financing of such construction project, including the use of surplus in the city's Light Department fund.

Section 4: That the City Council may provide on motion for the construction of said building by contract or city construction method, or the combination of both. Any contract authorized by the Council for the construction of said building or any part thereof, shall be deemed to be a contract authorized by this ordinance and as required by the provisions of Section 2, Chapter XII, of the City Charter; provided however, that construction shall not be commenced until after the adoption of the city's budget for the 1958-59 fiscal tax year.

Passed on first reading at a regular meeting of the Canby City Council this 7th day of April, 1958, and ordered posted in three (3) public and conspicuous places for a period of two (2) full calendar weeks as provided by City Charter and to come up for final reading and action by the Council at a regular meeting thereof to be held on the 5th day of May, 1958.
