ORDINANCE No. 415

AN ORDINANCE FIXING CHARGES FOR BUILDING SEWER PERMITS; AMENDING ORDINANCE No. 394; REPEALLING ORDINANCE No. 405; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY:

THE CITY OF CANBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Section 4-2 of Ordinance No. 394 adopted by the Canby City Council on September 4th, 1956, is hereby amended to provide as follows:

Section 4-2: Any person, firm or corporation desiring to make connection to a PUBLIC SEWER shall make application in person or by a duly authorized agent on forms provided by the City Recorder's office for a BUILDING SEWER PERMIT. Such application shall be filed in the office of the City Engineer or City Superintendent, as the case may be. If any part of the premises described in said application and which are to be connected to the PUBLIC SEWER have previously been assessed by the City of Canby for sanitary sewer improvements, there shall be paid to the City Recorder, upon the filing of such application, the sum of \$15.00; but if the said premises have not previously been assessed for a sanitary sewer improvement, then the sum of \$50.00 shall be paid to the City Recorder. The payment of such sums as herein provided, shall be in full payment for the right of the applicant to hook his BUILDING SEWER to the PUBLIC SEWER. If there is not an opening in the PUBLIC SEWER at the point of connection with the BUILDING SEWER, the City of Canby shall make the required opening/and install therein the necessary "T" or "Y" and the same shall be done at the expense of the City, notwithstanding any contrary provisions of Ordinance No. 394.

Section 2: That City Ordinance No. 405, adopted by the Canby City Council on the 16th day of December, 1957, be and the same is hereby repealed.

Section 3: It being deemed by the Canby City Council that an emergency exists, this ordinance shall become effective upon its final passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.

Passed on first reading at a regular meeting of the Canby City Council held this 7th day of April, 1958. Ordered posted in three (3) public and conspicuous places for a period of two (2) full calendar weeks as provided by City Charter and to come up for final reading and action of the Canby City Council at a regular meeting thereof to be held on the 5th day of May, 1958.
