ORDINANCE NO. 442

AN ORDINANCE FIXING A DAY FOR PUBLIC HEARING ON THE QUESTION OF ANNEXING ADJOINING LANDS TO THE CITY OF CANBY; PROVIDING FOR NOTICE OF SUCH HEARING; and DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City Council for the City of Canby, Oregon proposes to extend the boundaries of said City by the annexation of territory not now within the City but which is contiguous to it and all of which lies wholly within the County of Clackamas; and

WHEREAS, the City Council elects to dispense with submitting the question of annexation to the voters of said City, but intends to follow the procedure for annexation without election of City voters as provided in Oregon Revised Statutes 222.120; now therefore

THE CITY OF CANBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That Monday, August 13, 1962, at the hour of 8:00 o'clock P.M., Oregon Daylight Time, at the Canby City Hall at 182 N. Holly Street, in Canby, Clackamas County, State of Oregon, is hereby fixed as the time and place for a public hearing before the Canby City Council at which time the registered voters of said City may appear and be heard on the question of extending the City boundaries by the annexation of a contiguous territory.

<u>Section 2:</u> That the following is a legal description of the territory proposed to be annexed to the City of Canby, to-wit:

> Beginning at a point in the center of the Territorial Road in Section 28, Township 3 South, Range 1 East of the Willamette Meridian, in Clackamas County, State of Oregon, which point is due North of the Northeast corner of Lot 59, Canby Gardens; running thence South to the Northeast corner of said Lot 59; thence continuing South along the East line of Lots 59, 58 and 57, Canby Gardens, to the Southeast corner of Lot 57, Canby Gardens; thence West along the South line of Lots 57 and μ 8 to the Southwest corner of Lot μ 8, Canby Gardens; thence North along the West line of said Lot μ 8 and along the West line of Lots μ 7, Canby Gardens, to the South line of Territorial Road; thence Northeasterly along the Southerly line of said Road and the Northerly line of Amrine Road; thence North to the center of the Territorial Road; thence North π 8° 2μ ⁴ East along said centerline 20 feet more or less to an iron

pipe set at the Southwest corner of that tract conveyed to Mary L. Collins et al by deed recorded September 26, 1946 in Deed Book 377 page 429, records of Clackamas County, Oregon. Thence North along the West line of said Collins tract 5893.8 feet to an angle corner on the West line of said Collins tract; thence North 8° 30' East 654 feet more or less to an iron pipe at the most Westerly corner of the tract conveyed to Crown Zellerbach Corp. by deed recorded May 23, 1946 in Book 368 page 33; thence South 45° 26' East along the South line of said Crown Zellerbach Tract to an intersection with the Southerly line of the Molalla Forest Road as said roadway is described in Deed Book 358 at page 92; thence Southeasterly and Southerly along said right of way line to an intersection of said line with the centerline of the Territorial Road; thence South 68° 45' West along the said centerline to the place of beginning.

Section 3: That notice of the public hearing on the question of annexation shall be published once each week for two successive weeks prior to the day of hearing in the Canby Herald, a newspaper of general circulation printed and published in the City of Canby; and notices of such hearing shall be posted in four public places in the City for a like period. The City Recorder is hereby authorized and directed to attend to the publication and posting of such notice.

Section 4: That no election is required in the City on the question of this annexation.

<u>Section 5:</u> It being deemed by the Canby City Council that an emergency exists, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its final passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.

Passed on first reading at a regular meeting of the Canby City Council held on the 2nd day of July, 1962; ordered posted in three public and conspicuous places in the City of Canby for a period of two full calendar weeks as profided by the Canby City Charter, and to come up for final reading and action of the Canby City Council at a special meeting thereof to be held on Monday, the 23rd day of July, 1962 at the hour of 8:00 o'clock P.M., Oregon Daylight Time, at the Canby City Hall.
