

ORDINANCE NO. 447

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO MINORS; AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 309;  
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF CANBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That Section 16 entitled "POOL HALLS, MINORS VISITING" of Ordinance No. 309 adopted January 3, 1939, is hereby repealed.

Section 2: That Section 18 entitled "MINORS, EMPLOYMENT IN CERTAIN PLACES PROHIBITED" of Ordinance No. 309 adopted January 3, 1939, is hereby amended to provide as follows:

Section 18: MINORS, EMPLOYMENT IN CERTAIN PLACES PROHIBITED.

Any person who shall employ a minor in or about a beer parlor, cardroom or dancehall shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$10.00 nor more than \$100.00, or by imprisonment in the County jail for a term of not less than two, nor more than twenty-five days, or by both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the Court.

Section 3: It being deemed by the Canby City Council that an emergency exists this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its final passage and approval by the Mayor.

Passed on first reading at a regular meeting of the Canby City Council held on the 7th day of January, 1963; ordered published at full length in the Canby Herald, once a week for a period of two consecutive weeks as provided by the Canby City Charter and to come up for final reading and action of the Council at a regular meeting thereof to be held on the 4th day of February, 1963, at 8:00 o'clock P.M., Standard Oregon Time in the Canby City Hall.
