ORDINANCE NO. 456

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING WATER RATES IN THE CITY OF CANEY; REPEALING ORDINANCES NO. 430 AND 433; AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 313; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF CANBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That Ordinance No. 430 adopted by the Canby City Council November 16, 1959, is hereby repealed; and Ordinance No. 433 adopted by the Canby City Council April 18, 1960, is hereby repealed.

Section 2: Rule 15 of Camby City Ordinance No. 313 adopted by the Camby City Council January 6, 1939, is hereby amended to provide as follows:

All water whether for industrial, commercial or residential purposes shall be sold in accordance with the schedule of minimum monthly charges and rates as set forth herein.

All services $2 \cdot 1/2$ " and larger shall be covered by specific written agreement with the City, but in no case shall the rates and charges be less than set forth above.

Section 3: It being deemed by the Canby City Counciltat an amergency exists, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its final passage and approval by the Mayor; and the water charges as changed and imposed by this Ordinance shall be applied to meter readings made during the first calendar month immediately following the month in which this Ordinance is adopted and to all monthly meter readings thereafter until changed by further Ordinance.
