

ORDINANCE NO. 468

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 431; AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 394; INCREASING SEWER PERMIT CHARGES; INCREASING AND EXTENDING SEWER SERVICE CHARGES; AUTHORIZING TRANSFER OF FUNDS TO SEWER SINKING FUND; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF CANBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Ordinance No. 431 adopted by the Canby City Council January 18, 1960, is hereby repealed; and Section 4 - 2 of Ordinance No. 394 is amended to read as follows:

"Section 4 - 2: There shall be three classes of building sewer permits: (1) for residential use, (2) for commercial use, and (3) for industrial use. In any case the owner or agent shall make application on a special form furnished by the Canby City Recorder and upon the filing of said application, said owner or agent shall pay to the Canby City Recorder the sum of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) as a permit fee for the right of the applicant to hook to the public sewer."

Section 2: Section 10 - 1 of Ordinance No. 394 is amended to read as follows:

"Section 10 - 1: There is hereby levied and imposed upon all water users within or without the corporate limits of the City of Canby and who connect to a public sewer at any time subsequent to the effective date of this Ordinance, a sewer service charge as follows:

- (a) Residential user charge shall be a flat rate of \$1.50 per month.
- (b) Commercial user charge shall be a flat rate of \$3.25 per month.
- (c) Industrial user charge shall be a flat rate of \$3.25 per month.
- (d) In addition to the foregoing monthly flat rate charges, the owners, operators or persons responsible therefor of all apartment houses, trailer parks or multi-family dwellings shall be charged an additional monthly sewer service charge of \$1.00 for each separate dwelling unit; except that no such additional charge shall be made in any case where such separate dwelling unit is served by a separate electric meter, and such meter indicates no kilowatt usage for the current month.
- (e) In addition to the foregoing monthly flat rate charges, the owners, operators or persons responsible therefor of all hotels and motels shall be charged an additional monthly sewer service charge of 50¢ for each separate unit.

Section 3: Commencing with the first calendar month following the adoption of this Ordinance, the Canby City Recorder shall transfer monthly to the SEWER SINKING FUND created by Ordinance No. 409 the sum

of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) from all sewer permit charges collected and also the sum of One Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$150.00) per month from the gross income of the City from the collection of sewer service charges.

Section 4: All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith or inconsistent with this Ordinance shall be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section 5: It being deemed by the Canby City Council that an emergency exists, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its final passage by the Canby City Council and approval by the Mayor; and the increased sewer permit charges and increased sewer service charges as imposed by this Ordinance shall be applied and made during the first calendar month immediately following the month in which this Ordinance is adopted and continuing thereafter until changed by further Ordinance.

Passed on first reading at a regular meeting of the Canby City Council this 1st day of June, 1964; ordered published at full length for a period of two (2) weeks as provided by the Canby City Charter and to come up for final reading and action of the Canby City Council at a regular meeting thereof to be held on the 6th day of July, 1964, at 8:00 o'clock p.m., Oregon Daylight Savings Time, at the Canby City Hall.


