AN ORDINANCE INCREASING WATER RATES AND CHARGES; AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 313; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF CANBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Rule 15 of Ordinance No. 313 is hereby amended

to provide as follows:

Rule 15.

(a) All water whether for industrial, commercial, institutional or residential purposes shall be sold in accordance with the schedule of minimum monthly charges and rates as set forth herein:

Meter Size	RATE SCHEDULE Amount of Water in Cubic Feet	Minimum Charges and Rates per 100 Cubic Feet
5/8" and 3/1"	First 600 Next 400 Next 500 Next 500 All over 2,000	\$3.00 Minimum .30 .25 .20 .10
1"	First 1,000 Next 500 Next 500 All over 2,000	\$5.00 Minimum .25 .20 .10
1 1/2"	First 2,600 All over 2, 600	\$7.00 Minimum .10
2"	First 4,800 All over 4,800	\$9.00 Minimum .10

(b) All services 2 1/2" and larger shall be covered by specific written agreement with the City, but in no case shall the rates and charges be less than set forth above.

(c) Standpipe service for fire protection shall be charged monthly at the rate of \$2.00 per inch of pipe diameter.

(d) The billings by the City shall be discounted 10% on all billings made to public buildings, schools, churches, lodges, clubs and organizations not operated for commercial purposes. The discounted billing rate shall be applied to all meter readings made after July 1, 1967, and to all meter readings made thereafter.

Section 2: It being deemed by the Canby City Council that an emergency exists, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its final reading and passage by the Council; and the increased water rate schedule shall be applied to all meter readings made after July 1, 1967, and to all meter readings made thereafter.
