

ORDINANCE NO. 518

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 452 TO PERMIT CONDITIONAL USES IN THE M-1 LIGHT INDUSTRIAL ZONE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF CANBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1: Ordinance No. 452 (Zoning Ordinance) enacted July 15, 1963, is hereby amended in the following particulars:

(a) The word "none" under Conditional Uses permitted in a light industrial zone M-1 is hereby deleted.

(b) The following conditional uses are now permitted in a light industrial zone M-1: Motels, hotels and similar transient accommodations; and other uses as determined by the Planning Commission.

Section 2: It being deemed by the Canby City Council that an emergency exists, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its final passage by the Council.


Passed on first reading at a special meeting of the Canby City Council held on the 23rd day of August, 1968; ordered posted in three public and conspicuous places in the City of Canby for a period of two full calendar weeks as provided by the Canby City Charter, and to come up for final reading and action of the Canby City Council at a special meeting thereof to be held on Monday, September 9, 1968, at the hour of 7:30 o'clock p.m., Oregon Daylight Saving Time at the Canby City Hall.


