

ORDINANCE NO. 535

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT FOR SEWAGE TREATMENT PLANT EXPANSION.

WHEREAS, the qualified legal voters of the City of Canby approved a Charter Amendment at a special City election duly and legally called and held on November 3, 1970, for the purpose of authorizing the issuance and sale of general obligation bonds of the City in the sum of \$400,000 for the purpose of constructing additions to the City sewage treatment plant; constructing interceptor and main sewer lines; constructing pump stations and pressure mains; and generally rehabilitating the existing sewer system; and

WHEREAS, the Canby City Council has proceeded to issue and sell the bonds authorized for the said purposes and employed the engineering firm of Cornell, Howland, Hayes & Merryfield of Corvallis, Oregon, to prepare the plans and supervise the construction of a sewage treatment plant expansion, and bids for the said improvement project were publicly called for the time and in the manner required by law, and received and publicly opened by the Canby City Council on April 1, 1971. The work contemplated consists of modification of an existing pump station; construction of a 330,000-gallon aeration basin, a 50-foot diameter clarifier, a 50-foot diameter aerobic digester, a motor control and sludge pump building, two 200,000-gallon and one 450,000-gallon humus storage ponds and miscellaneous pump, piping and other alterations and improvements to the existing sewage treatment plant; and

WHEREAS, there were a total of twelve bids for construction of said improvements, and the City Council and its engineer have examined the bids and the qualifications of the bidders and have determined that the lowest, which was also an acceptable bid, was that of Everett L. Wiggins for a total construction and contract cost of \$251,738, which included the engineer's recommended items

of equipment; and

WHEREAS, the low bidder is ready, willing and able to proceed with the construction contract in accordance with the plans and specifications for the said improvement project, and it is necessary that a formal written contract be approved and executed by the contractor and the City, NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY OF CANBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the Bid Proposal of Everett L. Wiggins for construction of the City's sewage treatment plant expansion according to the engineer's plans and specifications for said project and for the total contract amount of \$251,738, be and the same is hereby approved; and the Mayor and City Recorder are hereby authorized and directed to make, execute and deliver in the name of and on behalf of the City of Canby an appropriate Construction Contract with Everett L. Wiggins.

Section 2: The construction costs and contract charges shall be paid as they accrue and when approved for payment by the engineering firm of Cornell, Howland, Hayes & Merryfield from the proceeds of the sale of the City's sewer bonds now on deposit in the special account called the "SEWER DEPARTMENT CONSTRUCTION ACCOUNT" which was created by the Council's Resolution No. CVII adopted December 21, 1970.


Section 3: It being deemed by the Canby City Council that an emergency exists, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its final reading and passage by the Canby City Council.

Passed on first reading of the Canby City Council at a special meeting thereof on the 8th day of April, 1971; ordered posted as provided by the Canby City Charter and to come up for final reading and action of the Canby City Council at a special meeting thereof to be held on the 26th day of April, 1971, at the hour of 7:30 o'clock p.m., Oregon Daylight Saving Time, at the

Canby City Hall.
