## ORDINANCE NO. 563

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH B. J. FORD TRACTOR CO. FOR PURCHASE OF AN ALL WHEEL DRIVE TRACTOR.

WHEREAS, the Canby City budget for the current fiscal year includes an item for purchase of equipment for the Sewer Department; and additional funds for such purposes are also available to the City from grant participations administered by the U. S. ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY through Region X office at Seattle, Washington; and

WHEREAS, there is an immediate need for machinery to be used for removal of sludge at the City's sewage treatment plant and also for other City purposes; and

WHEREAS, the City's Superintendent of Public Works has prepared detailed specifications for an "all wheel drive tractor, including front end loader, backhoe and other specified equipment," which will be adequate for the sludge removal problems at the sewer treatment plant and can also be used for a variety of other City purposes; and

WHEREAS, the City has called and received bids for the purchase of this equipment, which were received and publicly opened at 4:00 p.m., Pacific Standard Time, at the Canby City Hall on Friday, December 17, 1972. The only bid received which conformed to the bidding requirements and the specifications for said equipment was that of B. J. FORD TRACTOR CO. of 3593 Silverton Road N.E., Salem, Oregon 97303. The bid as submitted by the said company was for \$24,440.00, and the company is ready, willing and able to proceed with the delivery of the equipment in accordance with the specifications and proposal for the same, and it is necessary that a formal written purchase order be approved and executed by the City and the successful bidder; now, therefore,

THE CITY OF CANBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>: The bid proposal of B. J. FORD TRACTOR CO. of Salem, Oregon, for sale to the City of one (1) all wheel drive

tractor, including front end loader, backhoe and other specified equipment, and for the total bid price of \$24,440.00, is hereby approved and accepted; and the Mayor and City Recorder are hereby authorized and directed to make, execute and deliver in the name of and on behalf of the City of Canby an appropriate purchase order contract with the said B. J. Ford Tractor Co.

Section 2: The purchase price which was the bid price of \$24,440.00 shall be paid upon receipt of billings and after delivery and inspection of the equipment and approval by the Superintendent of Public Works and the City Council from funds from the U. S. Environmental Protection Agency which have been allocated and approved and estimated in the sum of \$9,165.00; and that the balance of said purchase price be paid from budgeted funds for this purchase which are now on hand in the Sewer Fund Account No. 638.

<u>Section 3</u>: Inasmuch as there is an urgency to complete the purchase of the equipment as bid and take delivery as soon as possible because of sludge removal problems at the sewage treatment plant, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its second reading and final passage by the Canby City Council.

Passed on first reading of the Canby City Council at a regular meeting thereof on January 15, 1973; ordered posted as provided by the Canby City Charter, and to come up for final reading and action of the Canby City Council at a regular meeting thereof on Monday, February 5, 1973, at the hour of 8:00 o'clock p.m., Pacific Standard Time, at the Canby City HaN.
