

ORDINANCE 565

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE PURCHASE OF RADIO COMMUNICATION EQUIPMENT FOR THE CITY OF CANBY; ACCEPTING BID FOR SALE; DIRECTING EXECUTION OF PURCHASE AGREEMENT; PROVIDING FOR PAYMENT; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Canby has heretofore advertised for and received bids for sale to the City of Radio Communications Equipment in accordance with specifications prepared by the City Superintendent and approved by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the bids as advertised were publicly opened at the regular meeting of the Council March 20, 1972, at 8:30 p.m. and consideration of all bids was delayed pending study and recommendation by a special committee appointed by the Mayor for such purpose; and

WHEREAS, the special committee so appointed has considered all bids tendered and the respective pieces of equipment described therein and has made report to the Mayor and the City Council on the committee's findings and determination, and the committee having recommended unanimously the acceptance of the bid of GENERAL ELECTRIC COMPANY of Beaverton, Oregon, now, therefore,

THE CITY OF CANBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the bid of GENERAL ELECTRIC COMPANY of Beaverton, Oregon, for sale to the City of Canby, Oregon, of a Radio Communication system as described in said bid and for the total selling price of NINE THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE AND 00/100 (\$9,633.00) DOLLARS be and the same is hereby accepted.


Section 2: That the Mayor and the City Recorder for the City of Canby shall cause to be executed over their respective signatures a Purchase Agreement between the City of Canby and GENERAL ELECTRIC COMPANY of Beaverton, Oregon, and which said contract shall provide, among other things, for the cash payment of the purchase price of said equipment within thirty (30) days after delivery and providing the equipment delivered conforms to the specifications and details of the bid tendered and accepted.

Section 3: That payment of the purchase price for said radio equipment shall be made by the City Treasurer on a warrant drawn by the City Recorder from funds of the City heretofore appropriated for such purpose or otherwise from funds to be designated by the City Council, but no payment shall be made until such time as the City Council votes its approval and acceptance of the radio equipment purchased.

Section 4: All Ordinances, or parts of Ordinances, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.


Section 5: It being deemed by the Canby City Council that an emergency exists, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its final passage and approval by the Mayor.


