

ORDINANCE NO. 593

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH PARKER NORTHWEST PAVING COMPANY FOR CONSTRUCTION OF IMPROVEMENTS TO N. E. 2ND AVENUE IN LID No. 5.

WHEREAS, the City Engineer's report and estimate of costs for construction of improvements to N. E. 2nd Avenue in LID No. 5 was reviewed by the City Council and the public at a public hearing on June 16, 1975; and

WHEREAS, there were not sufficient remonstrances to or objections against the proposed improvement project to defeat it, cause its abandonment, or justify further delay in its construction, and the Council adopted Resolution No. CXCIII (193) on August 25, 1975, providing for the work to be done on contract; and

WHEREAS, bids for the construction of said improvements were previously called and publicly opened on July 31st, 1975, and the lowest and best bid was that of Parker Northwest Paving Company for a total bid price of \$35,154.00, which was less than the City Engineer's estimate of the total costs of said project; and

WHEREAS, Parker Northwest Paving Company is ready, able and willing to proceed with the construction contract in accordance with the plans and specifications therefor as prepared by the City's Engineer and approved by the Council, and it is necessary that a formal written contract be prepared and executed by the successful bidder and the City; now, therefore,

THE CITY OF CANBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1: The bid proposal of Parker Northwest Paving Company for the construction of improvements in and to N. E. 2nd Avenue for

LID No. 5 according to the plans and specifications for said project prepared by the City Engineer and for the total bid price of \$35,154.00 is hereby approved and accepted. The improvements to be made and which are to be covered by the contract include, among other things, approximately 886 lineal feet of commercial and industrial street construction, including storm sewer construction, grading, subgrade preparation, concrete curbs, base rock and asphalt pavement. The Mayor and City Recorder are hereby authorized and directed to make, execute and deliver in the name of and on behalf of the City of Canby an appropriate construction contract with the said Parker Northwest Paving Company for its bid and a contract price of \$35,154.00.

Section 2: The construction costs and contract price shall be paid on receipt and approval of billings from funds of the City which the Council determines are available at the time for such purpose, and may include borrowing of any Department's invested funds which are not restricted for short-term borrowing. The City Council may also in its discretion authorize by Resolution any other short-term borrowing within the City's Charter limitation for floating indebtedness, it being the City Council's plan and intention to repay such borrowing from the collection of assessments to be made to the benefited properties in accordance with the provisions of Ordinance No. 393 and the sale of improvement bonds which are authorized under that Ordinance and the Bancroft Bonding Act.

Section 3: It being deemed by the Canby City Council that an emergency exists, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its final reading and passage by the Canby City Council.

Passed on first reading of the Canby City Council at a special meeting thereof on the ~~8th~~ day of September, 1975; ordered posted as provided by the Canby City Charter and to come up for final reading and action of the Canby City Council at a special meeting thereof to be held on Monday , the 29th day of September, 1975, at the hour of 8:00 o'clock p.m. at the Canby City Hall.
