## ORDINANCE NO. 594

AN ORDINANCE FIXING COMPENSATION FOR THE SERVICES OF CITY COUNCIL-MEN AND MAYOR; REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 426; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS the Mayor and Councilmen for the City of Canby are currently serving in their respective capacities as elective officials of the City and the Mayor is paid from the funds of the City budgeted for such purpose the sum of Twelve Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$12.50) for each regular or special meeting of the Council which he attends; and each Councilman is paid from said funds the sum of Seven Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$7.50) for each regular or special meeting of the Council which he attends as provided by Ordinance No. 426; and

WHEREAS the growth of the City and its business has made and will continue to make a greater demand on the time and ability of such officials; and

WHEREAS a sum of money is currently budgeted for such purpose and it is considered prudent business and reasonably necessary that the compensation of the Mayor and Councilmen be increased, now therefore

THE CITY OF CANBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The duly elected and qualified Mayor for the City of Canby shall be paid from funds of the City budgeted for such purpose the sum of One Hundred Dollars (\$100) per month and each duly elected and qualified Councilman shall also be paid from said funds the sum of Seven Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$7.50) for each Council Meeting which he attends.

<u>Section 2.</u> Neither the Mayor nor any Councilman shall be paid for attendance at any Committee meeting or other meeting of the City's officials.

Section 3. The payments to be made to Councilmen, as provided by this Ordinance, shall commence with the first meeting of the Council held following the final passage of this Ordinance and the payments to the Mayor shall commence with the month immediately following the enactment of this Ordinance. Such payments shall be made monthly in the regular course of business and no further order, authorization or approval for such payments shall be required.

<u>Section 4.</u> Ordinance No. 426, enacted September 8, 1959, is hereby repealed; and all other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are also hereby repealed.

<u>Section 5.</u> This Ordinance shall take effect at 12:01 A.M., October 1, 1975.
