

ORDINANCE NO. 714

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING CONTRACT WITH RICHARD OF ROCKFORD, INC.
FOR PURCHASE OF SEWAGE TREATMENT PLANT AERATION EQUIPMENT; AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Canby has heretofore advertised for and received bids for sewage treatment plant aeration equipment. The specifications were prepared by the City's engineering firm and approved by the Council; and

WHEREAS, the notice and call for bids was duly and regularly given by publication in the Canby Herald and the Daily Journal of Commerce on December 30, 1981, and January 6, 1982; said bids were received and opened in Canby City Hall on January 13, 1982; and

WHEREAS, only one bid was received for this purchase, i.e., from Richard of Rockford, Inc., Rockford, Illinois, for the purchase by the City of Canby of two (2) 25HP Oxy Jet submerged jet aerators and 50 HP Hoffman Centrifugal blower, for the total sum of \$35,735; and

WHEREAS, the total amount of the bid was in excess of the engineer's estimate of \$31,576; however, notwithstanding the fact that the only bid received exceeded the estimate of the City's engineer by the sum of \$4,159, it was considered by the Canby City Council acting as the City's Contract Review Board to be an acceptable bid on the basis of price increases and exceptions to the specifications, which all appear to be reasonable, and upon the recommendations of the City's Engineers, Lee Engineering, Inc., it was approved and the contract authorized, now, therefore,

THE CITY OF CANBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: A contract or purchase order is authorized to be signed by the Mayor and attested by the City Recorder/Administrator for the purchase of two (2) 25 HP Oxy Jet submerged jet aerators and 50 HP Hoffman centrifugal blower from Richard


of Rockford, Inc., Rockford, Illinois, for its bid price of \$35,735. The purchase price is to be paid upon delivery of the equipment and its approval by the City's engineers and upon receipt of billings and approval of the same by the Canby City Council and the Superintendent of Public Works from the Sewer Reserve Fund in the current years budget.

Section 2: Inasmuch as there is an immediate need for the said equipment an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its enactment after final reading.


