

ORDINANCE NO. 626

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 525.

THE CITY OF CANBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Ordinance No. 525 enacted December 1, 1969, and entitled "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE TAKING OF FISH FROM THE WATERS STOCKED BY THE CITY OF CANBY LOCATED WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF ANY CANBY CITY PARK AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS." is hereby repealed effective immediately upon second and final reading and enactment of this Ordinance by the Canby City Council.
