

ORDINANCE NO. 657

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING CONSTRUCTION AND PURCHASE OF NEW FIRE TRUCK

WHEREAS, the City of Canby has heretofore advertised and received bids for a new pumping engine to be constructed on a 1979 model Ford chassis which will be a new fire truck for the City of Canby. The component parts of the unit include one (1) Seagrave C-8000-1000-750T, 1000 GPM pumping engine and a 1979 model Ford C-8000 chassis and the detailed plans and specifications were prepared by the City's Fire Chief and previously approved by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the notice of call for bids was duly and regularly published in the Daily Journal of Commerce in Portland, Oregon, on March 26, 1979, and April 2, 1979, and also in the Canby Herald on March 28, 1979; and

WHEREAS, bids were received as advertised and were opened by the City's Fire Chief on April 26, 1979, and the following bids were received:

WHEREAS, The Canby City Council as the City's contract review board met in regular session on May 2, 1979, and considered the bids and the reports and recommendations of the City's Fire Chief; and


WHEREAS, the bid of Sea-Western, Inc. was not only the low bid but also conformed in all respects to the plans and specifications for the required unit; now therefore,

THE CITY OF CANBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1: A contract is authorized to be signed by the Mayor and attested by the City Recorder/Administrator, for the purchase of a new fire truck from Sea-Western, Inc. for its bid price of \$68,547.80. The purchase price is to be paid upon receipt of billing(s) and approval of the City's Fire Chief and the Canby City Council from the Motor Pool Capitol Outlay Fund.

Section 2: In as much as the chassis price is firm only until May 15, 1979, and subject to increase after that date, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its enactment after final reading.

Submitted to the council and read the first time at a regular meeting thereof on Wednesday, May 16, 1979; ordered posted as provided by the Canby City Charter and scheduled for second reading and action of the Canby City Council at a regular meeting thereof on Wednesday, June 6, 1979, commencing at the hour of 7:30 o'clock P.M. at the Council Meeting Chambers at the Canby City Hall in Canby, Oregon.
