ORDINANCE NO. 667

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING CONTRACT FOR CONSTRUCTION OF INDUSTRIAL STREETS, STORM SEWER SYSTEM AND SANITARY SEWER IN LID #9.

WHEREAS, the Canby City Council adopted Resolution No. CCLXIX (269) on August 1, 1979, which provided for the time and manner of doing the work for construction of improvements to N.W. Third Avenue and N. W. Baker Drive, in LID #9; and

WHEREAS, the City's engineer prepared the detailed plans and specifications for said project and advertised for bids, which was published in the Daily Journal of Commerce, Portland, Oregon, on August 29 and September 4, 1979, and also in the Canby Herald on August 29, 1979; and

WHEREAS, bids were received, opened and publicly read aloud in the Canby City Hall at 2:00 o'clock P.M. on September 13, 1979, and a tabulation of bids received is attached hereto marked Exhibit "A" for identification purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Canby City Council as the City's Contract Review Board, met in regular session on September 19, 1979, and considered the bids, reports and recommendations of the City engineer and determined that the lowest and best bid was that of Parker Northwest Paving Co. which was accepted with no alterations. The bid as accepted is for a total construction cost of \$214,162.25; now therefore,

THE CITY OF CANBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1:</u> The Mayor and City Recorder are hereby authorized and directed to make, execute and deliver in the name of the City of Canby and on its behalf an appropriate contract with Parker Northwest Paving Co. of Oregon City, Oregon for the construction of improvements in LID #9 according to the plans and specifications of such project as prepared by the City's engineer and superintendent of Public Works, and the amount of such contract as now authorized is for the total of \$214,162.25.

Section 2: The contract price shall be paid upon completion of the work and receipt of billings and upon approval by the City engineer and City Council from a special budget item for local improvement district projects.

Section 3: An emergency is hereby declared to exist in order that the work may be started and completed as soon as possible and during this fall season and before the onset of winter weather which would delay the project and increase its cost.

Submitted to the Council and read the first time at a regular meeting thereof on Wednesday, October 3, 1979, and scheduled for second reading and action of the Canby City Council at a meeting thereof on the 7th day of November , 1979, commencing at the hour of 7:30 o'clock P.M. at the Council Meeting Chambers at the Canby City Hall in Canby, Oregon.
