

ORDINANCE NO. 681

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING PURCHASE OF MECHANIC'S TOOLS AND EQUIPMENT;  
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF CANBY ORDINANS AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1: The Mayor and City Recorder/Manager are authorized to purchase mechanic's tools and equipment to replace those items owned by city employee/mechanic Dale Yoder, and which were stolen from the City's Public Works Shop at 325 N.E. Second Avenue in this City.

Section 2: The total price of the purchase as authorized in Section 1 shall not exceed \$7,000 and the items purchased and prices to be paid shall first be approved by the Mayor, City Recorder/Manager, and Mr. Yoder, and title to all such items shall be delivered with them to Dale Yoder.


Section 3: Payment(s) for the purchases hereby authorized shall be made from the Motor Pool Line Item in the 1979-80 budget.

Section 4: Inasmuch as the stolen tools and equipment must be replaced immediately in order to continue the usual and normal jobs and repair projects in the City Shop, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its enactment after final reading.


