

ORDINANCE NO. 686

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING PURCHASE OF WHEEL TRACTOR BACKHOE-LOADER

WHEREAS, the City of Canby has heretofore advertised and received bids for the purchase of a wheel tractor backhoe-loader; and

WHEREAS, the notice of call for bids was duly and regularly published in the Canby Herald on September 10, 1980; and

WHEREAS, bids were received as advertised and were opened by the City's Engineer on September 24, 1980, and the following bids were received:

WHEREAS, the Canby City Council as the City's Contract Review Board, met in regular session on October 1, 1980, and considered the bids and reports and recommendations of the City Engineer; and

WHEREAS, the City Council determined that the lowest and best bid was that of Fischer Mill Supply, Inc. and purchase of the required wheel tractor backhoe-loader should be made from said company; now, therefore,

THE CITY OF CANBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: A contract or purchase order to be signed by the Mayor and attested by the City Recorder is approved for the immediate purchase of one (1) wheel tractor backhoe-loader from Fischer Mill Supply, Inc. for its bid price of \$17,641.00; and the purchase price shall be paid upon receipt of billing

and approval by the City Engineer from budgeted funds on hand in the City's Motor Pool Reserve Account for 1980-81 budget year.

Section 2: This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its enactment after final reading.

Submitted to the Council and read the first time at a regular meeting thereof on Wednesday, October 15, 1980; ordered posted as provided by the Canby City Charter and scheduled for second reading and action of the Canby City Council at a regular meeting thereof to be held on November 5, 1980, at the hour of 7:30 o'clock P.M. at the Council meeting chambers at the Canby City Hall in Canby, Oregon.
