

ORDINANCE NO. 687

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING CONSTRUCTION OF THE SOUTH ELM STREET SANITARY SEWER.

WHEREAS, the City of Canby has heretofore advertised and received bids for the construction of the South Elm Street Sanitary Sewer; and

WHEREAS, the notice of call for bids was duly and regularly published in the Canby Herald on October 1, 1980, and the Daily Journal of Commerce on October 2, 1980, and October 9, 1980; and

WHEREAS, bids were received as advertised and were opened by the City's Engineer on October 28, 1980, and the following bids were received:

WHEREAS, the Canby City Council as the City's Contract Review Board, met in regular session on November 5, 1980, and considered the bids and reports and recommendations of the City Engineer; and

WHEREAS, the City Council determined that the lowest and best bid was that of Northwest Underground on the basic bid, using native material for backfill; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has determined that select backfill will not be required in the area; now, therefore,

THE CITY OF CANBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1: The Mayor and City Recorder are hereby authorized and

directed to make, execute and deliver in the name of the City of Canby and on its behalf, an appropriate contract with Northwest Underground for its construction of the South Elm Street Sanitary Sewer and for which the City received its quote of \$19,963.50.


Section 2: The South Elm Street Sanitary Sewer project shall be constructed under the supervision of the City's Engineer and in accordance with his previously prepared plans and specifications for such project; and upon completion of the work the total cost shall be paid upon receipt of billing and approval of the City's Engineer and City Council from the City's Sewer Reserve Fund.


Section 3: An emergency is hereby declared to exist in order that the required work can be started and completed as soon as possible to benefit the citizens of Canby and this ordinance shall therefore take effect immediately upon its enactment after final reading.

Submitted to the Council and read the first time at a regular meeting thereof on Wednesday, November 19, 1980; ordered posted as provided by the Canby City Charter and scheduled for second reading and action of the City Council at a Special meeting thereof to be held on December 8, 1980, at the hour of 7:30 o'clock P.M. at the Council meeting chambers at the Canby City Hall in Canby, Oregon.
