

ORDINANCE NO. 693

AN ORDINANCE FIXING COMPENSATION FOR THE SERVICES OF CITY COUNCIL-  
PERSONS AND MAYOR AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 594.

THE CITY OF CANBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The duly elected and qualified mayor for the City of Canby shall be paid from funds of the City budgeted for such purpose the sum of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200) per month, and each duly elected and qualified councilperson shall also be paid from said funds the sum of Fifteen Dollars (\$15) for each council meeting which he or she attends.

Section 2: The payments to be made to the mayor and councilpersons as authorized by Section 1 of this ordinance shall commence July 1, 1980, and continue thereafter until changed by ordinance. Such payments shall be made monthly in the regular course of business and no further order, authorization or approval for such payments shall be required.


Section 3: Neither the mayor or any councilperson shall be paid for attendance at any committee meeting or other meeting of the City's officials.

Section 4: Ordinance No. 594 enacted September 29, 1975, is hereby repealed.
