ORDINANCE NO. 705

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE USE OR POSSESSION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES IN TWO OF THE CITY'S PARKS THE CITY OF CANBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1:</u> <u>USE OR POSSESSION PROHIBITED.</u> No person shall use or possess any alcoholic beverage in the City's Maple Street Park or Wait Park.

<u>Section 2:</u> <u>POLICE OFFICERS TO ENFORCE</u>. All police officers shall enforce the provisions of this ordinance.

<u>Section 3:</u> <u>COURT JURISDICTION</u>. The Canby Municipal Court and the Clackamas County District and Circuit Courts have concurrent jurisdiction over violations of this ordinance.

Section 4: <u>PUNISHMENT FOR VIOLATION</u>. A violation of this ordinance is punishable upon conviction by imprisonment in the County Jail for not more than sixty (60) days or by a fine of not more than \$200, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

<u>Section 5:</u> <u>EFFECTIVE DATE:</u> This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its enactment after final reading.
