

ORDINANCE NO. 709

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING CONTRACT WITH PARKER NORTHWEST PAVING CO.
FOR STREET REPAIRS AND IMPROVEMENTS TO VARIOUS AND SPECIFIED SECTIONS
OF CITY OF CANBY STREETS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Canby has planned and budgeted for street repairs and improvements to the following areas of the following listed streets in the City of Canby, to-wit:

North Holly Street
(From NE 2nd Avenue to Knights Bridge Road)

SW 6th Avenue
(From South Fir to South Elm Street)

SW 3rd Avenue
(From South Ivy to South Elm Street)

North Cedar Street
(From NW 6th Avenue to Knights Bridge Road)

South Knott Street
(From SE 2nd Avenue to Township Road)

SW 4th Avenue
(From South Elm to South Birch Street)

The said repairs and improvements shall include cleaning, tack-coat, and a 1-1/2 inch asphaltic concrete overlay over a total of 263,500 square feet of said streets; and

WHEREAS, money to pay the costs of said improvements has been budgeted in the 1981-82 Federal and State Revenue Sharing Account; and

WHEREAS, a call for bids was published in the Canby Herald on September 9, 1981, and in the Daily Journal of Commerce on September 8, 1981, and the bids were received and opened publicly on September 15, 1981, at 2 o'clock P.M. at the Canby City Hall; and

WHEREAS, only one bid was received for this project, to-wit:

WHEREAS, the City Council as the City's Contract Review Board has considered the matter and reviewed the bid and recommendations of the City Public Works Supervisor and concur that the bid of Parker Northwest Paving Co. is within the budget for the project and below the estimates of the City Public Works Department and that the contract should be awarded to the said Parker Northwest Paving Co.; now, therefore,

THE CITY OF CANBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The City's Public Works Supervisor is authorized to give a letter agreement to Parker Northwest Paving Co. to proceed with the street improvements and repairs to the portions of Canby City Streets set forth in the first paragraph of this ordinance, which shall include the cleaning, tack-coat, and 1-1/2 inch asphaltic concrete overlay on a total of 263,500 square feet of said streets, and which shall also include a total of 20 manhole risers, and which shall be performed in accordance with the plans and specifications of the City Public Works Supervisor, for the total bid price of \$63,763.10.

Section 2: The repair and improvement project shall be done under the supervision of the City's Public Works Supervisor in accordance with his previously prepared plans and specifications for such project; and upon the completion of said project and receipt of billings and approval of the Public Works Supervisor and the City Council, payment shall be made from the City's 1981-82 State and Federal Revenue Sharing Account.

Section 3: An emergency is hereby declared to exist in order that the required work can be started and completed as soon as possible and before inclement weather sets in, and this Ordinance shall therefore take effect immediately upon its enactment and final reading.

Submitted to the Council and read the first time at a regular meeting on October 7, 1981, and scheduled for second reading and action of the Canby

City Council at a special meeting thereof to be held on October 28, 1981, commencing at the hour of 7:30 o'clock P.M. at the Council meeting chambers at the Canby City Hall in Canby, Oregon.
