

ORDINANCE NO. 795

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE CITY RECORDER OF CANBY, COUNTY OF CLACKAMAS, OREGON TO EXECUTE A PURCHASE AGREEMENT FOR A USED THREE AXLE TRUCK FOR THE WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Canby has heretofore advertised and received bids for a used three axle truck for the Wastewater Treatment Plant; and

WHEREAS, notice of call for bids was duly and regularly published in the Canby Herald on July 16, 1986; and

WHEREAS, bids were received as advertised and were opened by the City Recorder on July 25, 1986, at 2:00 p.m., and the following bid was received:

WHEREAS, the Canby City Council as the City's Contract Review Board, met in regular session on Wednesday, August 6, 1986 and considered the bid and recommendation of the City Administrator; and

WHEREAS, the City Council determined that the bid received from Northside Ford Truck Sales, Inc., met the required specifications; now therefore

THE CITY OF CANBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Mayor and the City recorder are hereby authorized and directed to make, execute and deliver in the name of the City of Canby and on its behalf, an appropriate purchase agreement with Northside Ford Truck Sales, Inc. for a used three axle truck as per the bid submitted by Northwest Ford Truck Sales, Inc, at the agreed upon price of \$19,950.00.

Section 2. Emergency. An emergency is hereby declared to exist in order that the equipment may be ordered and placed into operation as soon as possible to benefit the citizens of the City of Canby and therefore this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its enactment upon final reading.

SUBMITTED to the Canby City Council and read the first time at a regular meeting thereof on August 6, 1986; ordered posted as


required by the Canby City Charter and scheduled for second reading thereof on August 20, 1986, commencing at the hour of 7:30 o'clock, p.m. at the Council meeting Chambers at the Canby City Hall in Canby, Oregon.
