## ORDINANCE NO. 796

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY RECORDER OF THE CITY OF CANBY, OREGON TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH PARKER NORTHWEST PAVING, INC. FOR IMPROVING A PORTION OF SOUTH ELM STREET IN THE CITY OF CANBY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, it is in the public interest to improve streets within the corporate limits of the City of Canby; and

WHEREAS, the City has previously entered into an intergovernmental agreement with the State of Oregon, Department of Transportation for the improvement of S. Elm Street south from S.W. Fourth Avenue to S.W. Thirteenth Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the state and federal funds available for the improvement of S. Elm Street were insufficient to finish the improvement south to S.W. Thirteenth Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the Canby City Council has determined it is in the best interest of the City that the improvements to S. Elm Street continue from S.W. Tenth to S.W. Thirteenth Avenue;

THE CITY OF CANBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Mayor and City Recorder of the City of Canby, Oregon, are hereby authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with Parker Northwest Paving, Inc. for the continued improvement on S. Elm Street north from S.W. Thirteenth Avenue until it connects with the previous improvements approximately 1,250 lineAl feet at a rate of \$46.92 per lineal foot.

<u>Section 2.</u> A copy of said agreement shall be attached hereto as "Exhibit A" and become a part hereof.

<u>Section 3.</u> Inasmuch as it is necessary to proceed with these improvements as quickly as possible to better promote the Page 1. Ordinance No. 796 public health, safety and welfare, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect immediately after final reading and enactment by the Canby City Council.
